BICILLIN L-A (Pen G) 2.4 MU/4mL	Add to formulary with QL	QL(4 ml per 7 days retail)
Sublocade	Add to formulary	
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Pentazocine/Naloxone HCl	Add to Formulary	
Lucemyra	Add to Formulary	
Aripiprazole	Remove PA with QL and AL	QL(1 ea daily); AL(At least 6 yrs old)
Tridesilon (Desonide)	Add to formulary with QL	QL(2 gm daily,30 day(s) limit)
