Dear NextLevel Health Provider;

Thank you for being the NextLevel Health (NLH) Provider. NLH is committed to providing access to holistic, high quality health care including the appropriate use of controlled substances pharmaceuticals. The **Pharmacy Restriction Program's** (PRP) goal is reduce the risk of narcotic medications misuse/abuse. The Illinois Department of Health and Family Services (HFS) runs a Recipient Restriction program (RRP) for fee for service members and Healthy Choice Illinois requires all managed care organizations to create their own program. NLH's program will provide additional oversight and care management for members whose pattern of usage of controlled substances may indicate risk of abuse, diversion, addiction, or overdose. Enrolled members will be restricted to one pharmacy for all medications and one prescriber for all controlled medications.

NLH will conduct a review of the member's medical history to determine if a member would benefit from enrollment in the recipient restriction program. Enrolled members will receive an enrollment letter, including their enrollment dates, designated provider and pharmacy and their appeal rights. Members enrolled in the HFS' RRP will be automatically be enrolled in NLH's program. Length of enrollment is until the last day of the 12th month. Members will be re-evaluated in months 11 or 12 of enrollment.
